MASK GUIDELINES

MEETING SPACES

The meeting rooms have enhanced safety measures for physical distancing and ongoing monitoring for maximum people allocated for the space.

DISTANCING

Participants are encouraged to respect physical distance. Colored lanyards will be provided to indicate the individual's comfort level with close contact.

HEALTH CHECK

Any participant exhibiting any symptoms should refrain from attending the meeting. All exhibitors will have shown proof of vaccination or negative test results.

COMMUNICATIONS

The WDS has limited touch-points by reducing printed materials. Your meeting program will be provided in digital format unless otherwise requested.

HAND HYGIENE

Meeting participants are encouraged to follow hand hygiene protocols including washing, using hand sanitizer, and limiting hand-to-hand contact with other attendees.

CLEANING & DISINFECTING

WDS and the Brookfield Conference Center have implemented solutions to neutralize environments and safeguard participants with continuous cleaning and disinfecting for all event areas.

- Hand sanitizing stations are available throughout the venue.
- Meal distribution adjustments have been made to limit interaction.
